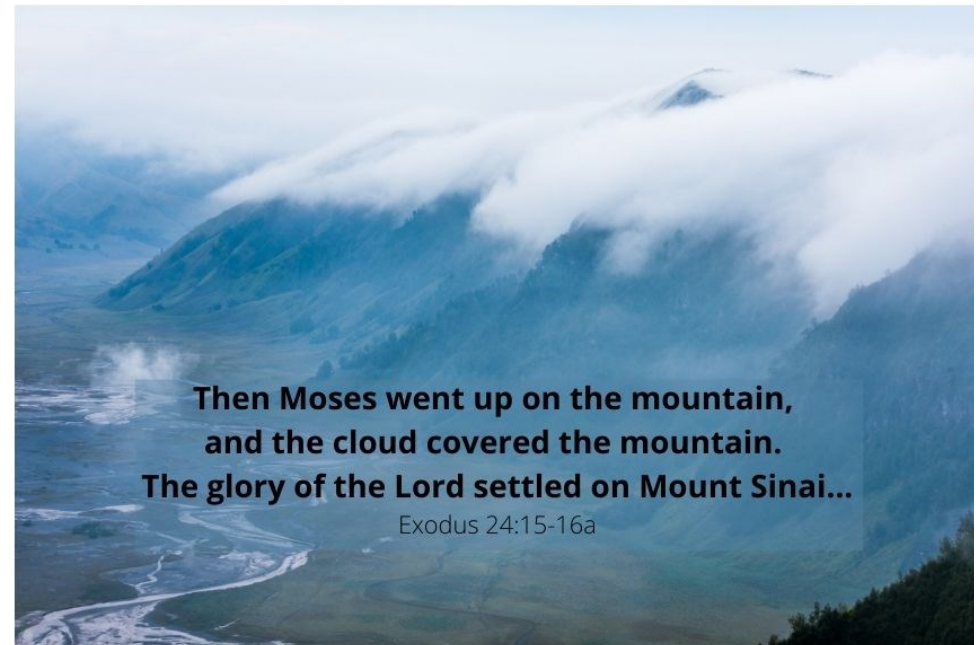


Meeting Time for Church Committees
