

Inaugural Worship Service for The Vine UMC is scheduled for July 9, at the open air auditorium at Trails West. Worship will be at 9:30 followed by food and fellowship. We have reserved the pool from 10 to 12.

New times for worship begin on July 16. Scottsbluff and Henry will worship at 9:00 am, while Mitchell and Morrill will worship at 11:00 am. We will still have worship in Scottsbluff on Saturday nights at 5:00 pm.

Vacation Bible School is July 23—26.

It is open to anyone from pre-school (potty-trained) to 5th grade. 6th Grade and older get to be our Crew Leaders. Please pre-register as soon as possible! We will be having a Kickoff BBQ at the Church from 4:30-6:00 on Sunday, July 23. This will be the only night we will be serving supper.

Merger Communications

Believing that open communications are the backbone of trust, our transition team has formed a Communications Team that will be led by Carolyn Applegate with Barb Ropp, Dawson Iasillo, Don Osborn and Joyce Hake taking various roles. If you would like to join our team, contact the church office. Pastor Craig is doing fine work with his Friday updates but more communication is needed. Your Communications Team will help, but everyone must realize no one person or group know all the hanging questions and answers. Your team will do its best but will require help from you with input and ideas and definitely following up by reading what is written, shown on line, posted on kiosks or bulletin boards and presented orally. Communications Team will appreciate and hear information and suggestions made to them.

The following are a few of the frequently asked questions with answers.

Who is on the Transition Team and why were they picked?

Names of persons serving on the Transition Team are listed on the kiosk in fellowship hall and include the Administrative Councils from each of the merging churches. These four committees, plus a few others who expressed interest in serving, make up the Transition Team. The role of the transition team is to lead us up to the point where the merger is completed and the church leadership voted on at charge conference will take over.

How long has the Transition Team been meeting?

The transition team met for the first time on March 26, 2023 at the Scottsbluff church. We met weekly on Sunday afternoons, in various locations to discuss the future, leadership, and direction of the merged church. Prior to the transition team, each church had up to five people serving on the exploratory team that met on a regular basis from August 8, 2022 to March 18, 2023. The time and dedication of both teams is appreciated.

How were the four names—New Vision, The Vine, Faith, Disciples selected?

The transition team considered over 50 names that had been suggested, and narrowed that list by multiple votes down to the four top names. These four had significantly more votes than all the rest.

Since the poll taken by the congregation was so close, are we locked into The Vine?

The decision made by the transition team prior to the opening of the poll, was that the name with the most votes would be the one we go with.

Who is making the decisions about operations in our new church?

The transition team is providing the leadership and direction for the new church until the charge conference on June 17 votes on leadership. Currently, we are relying on our existing leadership teams of each church to manage the work of their individual churches.

What is our timeline for becoming one church in four locations?

We will meet with our district superintendent, Rev. Cindy Karges, for our charge conference at 1 pm on June 17th where we will vote on the work of our transition team that requires charge conference approval, such as our nominated leadership team. We will begin as one church at our first worship service together on July 9, at Trails West at 9:30 am. All four locations will meet together for this celebratory event.

What are the employee positions in our new church? Who fills them? Who is writing the job descriptions and qualifications?

Pastor Craig Collins will be the Senior Pastor, and Pastor Joseph Schumacher will be the Discipleship Pastor. Their job descriptions are directed by the Book of Discipline and affirmed by the new SPRC and available for your review at the kiosk in Fellowship Hall. The transition team has discussed filling the position left by Missi Iasillo with a Director of Children and Student Ministries. We believe this could be a full time position subsidized with a grant from New Church Development from our conference. Other positions in the church have not been finalized and will be addressed by the transition team as time allows and then the new SPRC.

Why are we looking at new church school curriculum? Who is on the committee to decide the curriculum?

The pastors and transition team feel we need children, youth and adult curriculum that offers consistency across age levels while providing basic Christian and Wesleyan doctrine. We are utilizing our current children and youth leaders as well as some former educators in our churches as a subcommittee considering various curriculum.

What will be our new worship times? Will pastors rotate and how? Will sermon topics be similar in all churches?

Craig and Joe will work on the message together and rotate locations on a regular basis. Beginning July 15/16, the pastor preaching in Scottsbluff at 9 am will also preach in Morrill at 11 am, while the other pastor will preach in Scottsbluff at 5 pm on Saturday, and on Sunday preach at Henry at 9 am and Mitchell at 11 am. Our plan includes live streaming from both Scottsbluff and Mitchell locations.

Are we staying United Methodist or are we becoming something more evangelical?

We are a United Methodist Church and are committed to remaining such.

Is there a way to put forward my questions and concerns?

Communication is vitally important as we transition into our new church. Questions and recommendations are encouraged. You can post your questions to our pastors, lay leaders, communication team, current or upcoming leadership. This list is available on the kiosk in fellowship hall.
